## Bismarck man faces felony charge for leaving Bismarck Transition Center

A Bismarck man faces a felony charge for allegedly leaving the Bismarck Transition Center.

Kyle Armstrong, 18, was charged Monday with Class C felony escape.

Bismarck Police Sgt. Mark Buschena said employees of Bismarck Transition Center reported Armstrong had left the facility between 1 a.m. and 2:45 a.m. on Saturday. Police checked his last known address but did not locate him.

Armstrong was serving sentences in Bismarck Municipal Court for minor in possession, criminal trespass and fleeing an officer on foot. Buschena said he was slated to serve the sentences until May 9.

At 7:11 p.m. Saturday, dispatchers informed officers that Armstrong had returned to BTC.
