Acceptable Property & Arrival Information

The following information is provided to make your arrival at the Bismarck Transition Center less confusing and help you adjust more easily. We are located at 2001 Lee Ave in Bismarck, North Dakota 58504. Our phone number is 701-222-3440.

- **PLEASE BRING PICTURE IDENTIFICATION, BIRTH CERTIFICATE, MEDICAL INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION (when appropriate), VENTRANS IDENTIFICATIONS (when appropriate) AND YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD WITH YOU.**
- Please bring a 60-day supply of any needed prescription medication and any supplies needed to administer that medication (i.e. diabetic supplies, etc.).
- You will be charged a housing cost of \$8.00 per day. It is advised that you bring \$50.00 if possible for incidental expenses (laundry, commissary items, etc.).
- You are required to provide your own non-prescription medications and supplies such as: Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Band Aids, antacids, etc.
- Payment for all medical care and supplies is your responsibility.
- You must request permission to leave the facility.
- Aerosol cans are not allowed in BTC.
- Any products containing alcohol (such as after-shave, cologne, mouthwash, cleaning supplies, etc) are not allowed at BTC.
- Because of limited storage space, you will be allowed to bring in 7 days worth of clothing; based upon seasonal appropriateness, include proper coat and shoes.
- Small hand held music playing devices are allowed, but they can't have video playing or picture taking capabilities.
- You will be required to have an alarm clock.
- You will be responsible for your hygiene items.
- Cell phones are not allowed. Game Boy's, Play Stations, etc. are not allowed.
- No TV', DVD/VCR players, cameras, etc.
- If you arrive at the Assessment Center under the influence of drugs or alcohol you will not be admitted to the Assessment Center and will be referred back to your probation officer.
