VISITATION RULES AND GUIDELINES

We are a community-based program. These rules and guidelines have been established in order to provide a safe and functional environment for our clients. Please take a few minutes to review these.

Visitation must be prior scheduled through the Administrative staff at the facility. Clients must request this prior to the visit occurring. Approval of visits is subject to the benefit/harm that the visit may have on the individual's treatment progress.

All visitors must follow the conduct rules:

- a) Visitors who appeared impaired will not be allowed on campus.
- **b)** No tobacco products; vaping materials; drug paraphernalia; over the counter medications etc. may be brought into the facility. Doing so will result in immediate termination of the visit.
- c) No food or drink may be brought into the facility.
- **d)** Coffee, water, juice can be used while in the dining room. Please clean up after yourself when doing so.
- e) Children must be kept to your table and prevent them from disturbing other persons in the visiting area)
- **f)** Noise levels must be kept at an acceptable range as to not disturb other persons in the visiting area.
- **g)** Cell Phones will not be allowed inside the visitation area without staff approval due to privacy reasons.
- h) Visitation occurs in our dining room and you may only leave it to utilize the restrooms.
- i) Appropriate dress is mandated. The following is a list of inappropriate dress. This list is not absolute and any dress deemed inappropriate will not be allowed.
 - I. Spandex tops or pants
 - II. Short shorts
 - **III.** Transparent (any see-through top, skirt or pants)
 - **IV.** Clothing without the proper undergarments (bra, slip and underwear)
 - **V.** Vest (down-filled type)
 - **VI.** Any skirt or dress that is two (2) inches above the knee
 - **VII.** All shirts and tops must cover the midriff area at all times
 - **VIII.** Hats, caps or head scarves
 - **IX.** Tank-type tops are not allowed as an outer garment. All tops, shirts or blouses must have sleeves and must be worn with a bra (females). Tops must not be excessively low cut.
