Re: Memorandum of Understanding

To Whom it May Concern-

I am writing this letter as confirmation that the Glendive Medical Center will provide medical care and SANE certified nurses for PREA incidents reported at the WATCH East program.

My Security Coordinator has completed NIC PREA investigation training and my entire staff have received training to ensure they understand their roles in any reported incident.

If an incident of sexual assault/abuse occurs, within-seventy-two (72) hours referrals will be made to Glendive Medical Center where trained professionals will gather evidence, examine the resident, and make assessments and referrals as necessary.

If the sexual assault/abuse occurred more than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the initial complaint, Glendive Police Department may request evidence collection, but it will be up to the hospital staff to make the final determination whether a rape kit will be completed.


Glendive Medical Center will have such exams conducted by a Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner (SAFE) or a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE). If SAFE or SANE examiners are not available, the examinations will be performed by another qualified medical practitioner. Staff will document their efforts to provide SAFE or SANE professionals in the inmate's progress notes and in all incident reports.

Victim advocates will be made available throughout the forensic examination and any investigation procedures. Provisions will be made for the testing of sexually transmitted diseases, prophylactic treatment, and release of information for the purpose of medical management of involved persons.


